

How to attend a Microsoft Teams Live event

In this course, the Live events will take place via **Microsoft Teams Live Events**. As an **attendee** of a live event, you can watch live events and participate in the moderated Q&A. You cannot share audio or video during the live event. If you post a question or comment in the Q&A, please wait for it to be approved by the host in order for it to appear publicly.

Before watching a Live event, ensure that your browser allows third-party cookies and that your browser supports [Microsoft Teams](#) and [Microsoft Azure Media Player](#).

To join the live event:

1. Open the live event link which has been provided to you.
2. If you open the live event using the Teams App, you will join the event in Teams.
3. If you open the event from your email account or, you can join using the Teams App, or using your browser. The simplest way to join is anonymously using your browser (**no account or sign in required**). Alternatively, if you have an educational license, you can sign in to your Microsoft account.
4. If you're attending the live event using a browser, it's best to use web browsers like Chrome, Firefox, or Edge, which are media-source extension (MSE)-enabled.
5. If the live event has not started, you will see the following message displayed on your screen "The live event has not yet started". In this case, wait for the live event to start.
6. You will have the option to watch the live event with subtitles. You may choose from one of the 5 languages which have been preselected by the event's host and English.
7. Once the live event has ended, you will be able to watch the recording later on using a link provided to you by the host.
